Introduction

The East Sussex Cycling Association was formed on 10th November 1946 at the Ash Tree Inn, Ashburnham. Born out of frustration at the lack of post war racing opportunities for clubs in the area, it was the inspiration of two men, Roy Humphrey of the now disbanded Uckfield and District CC and Eastbourne Rovers' Bill Collins. With a resurgent enthusiasm for cycling, following the Second World War, they were determined to improve the lot of the East Sussex racing cyclist.



At that inaugural meeting they were joined by representatives from four other clubs; Bexhill Wheelers, Hastings & St Leonards C & AC, Rye & District Wheelers and the Royal Tunbridge Wells Albion CC. Adopting the Ash Tree as its badge, the East Sussex Cycling Association took root, branched out and grew into what it is today. Just think, 65 years on we marked its anniversary by hosting the 2011 RTTC National 24 Hour Championship – how proud they would have been.

In relatively recent times many of the records of the Association have gone astray with only sketchy accounts of the time trial results remaining from the past couple of decades.

Over time I will endeavour to compile the information I do have from the handwritten ledgers, but in the meantime I have produced this compressive record of all the events and activities during 2011, the 65th anniversary year, together with a summary of the ESCA award and event winners since 2006, the 60th anniversary year, to the present day.

We owe a tremendous debt of gratitude to everyone who helped and supported the event with two in particular, whose drive and enthusiasm made it all happen: Esther Carpenter and Mike Hayler. In the 24 hour result sheet Esther gave us her Organiser's viewpoint:

In 1946 when the East Sussex Cycling Association was formed, time trials were private and confidential, riders wore black alpaca jackets and black tights when they raced and anyone over 30 who raced was considered an oddity. Time trailists rose in the dark and rode out to the start of an event, rolled their possessions in their capes and tucked the bundle under a hedge. There was no 24 Hour National Championship in that year as the Championship did not appear on the calendar until 1948. The national record was 444.75 miles and had been set in 1935.

I'm sure that the founding fathers of ESCA would not have believed that 65 years later a 47 year old man from Cheshire would arrive at a smart village hall with his entourage, join 92 other men and women who, with few exceptions, all had at least one supporting car, all of them dressed in tight fitting shorts and jersey in all colours of the rainbow, to blast his way round the rolling roads of the county and add 16 miles to the record he himself had set fourteen years earlier. Andy Wilkinson's new record of 541.17 miles seems unbeatable but this unassuming man is already suggesting that a few more miles will be added to it in the near future by another superman.

The 24 Hour Past and Present

Although some die hard 24 hour enthusiasts are willing to travel for the pleasure, long gone are the days when the like was a regular fixture in the South; and for some local riders it was a once in cycling lifetime chance to experience such an event on their very own doorsteps.

However not all on the 2011 start sheet were strangers to the occasion having ridden before, with some notable successes.

Pushing the Boundaries

It seems personalities and politics are nothing new in the realms of ESCA as this excerpt from Michael Rabbets' Fifty Years of ESCA – Chapter 5 Boundaries and bother, shows:

ESCA's reputation spread pretty quickly – almost too quickly, because no one had worked out how far its territory should extend. Hastings Warrior CC became the seventh member of the association in 1949 and three others followed in 1950 – Tunbridge Wells Road Club, Senlac RC and Lewes and Newhaven RC (soon renamed Lewes Wanderers CC, reviving a pre-war East Sussex Club). But 12 months later, East Grinstead CC, Central Sussex CC and the Heath CC (based in Haywards Heath) successfully applied to be allowed in and ESCA's boundaries were defined for the first time: "To follow the A23 road from Surrey/Sussex boundary to the boundary of Brighton, but excluding that town."

Six years later, many eyebrows were raised when a membership application arrived from Southborough & District Wheelers. ("Southborough – isn't that in Kent?") The dust didn't settle until ESCA clubs had given Southborough the nod in a postal vote.

That was nothing compared with the high drama of Brighton Mitre's attempt to affiliate. At the 1960 AGM, a proposal that all clubs within the geographic boundaries of Sussex should be invited to join was ruled out of order. Two months passed, and the Management Committee refused the Mitre's application by six votes to three, after a long debate.

Boundary changes didn't seem to be the only issue. There were dark suggestions that there were wild men hidden in the Mitre, presumably hoping to jump out and frighten timid ESCAbods. But the Mitre's supporters didn't give up. A special general meeting was called, at which the boundary was changed to include Brighton. The Mitre were welcomed into the fold, by 15 votes to nine.

Other Brighton based clubs also became affiliated later in the 'sixties: the Fortune CC (a racing offshoot of Brighton YHA), Prestonville Nomads, Brighton Premier CRC and Brighton Excelsior. Crawley Wheelers were another 'sixties addition.

Not that the issue of exclusiveness was over. It came to the fore again when a club from well across the border, Worthing Excelsior, asked to join at the end of 1974. Yet another special general meeting was called, to consider yet another boundary change. Some who were there felt that to extend into West Sussex would lose ESCA's compactness and finally abandon the original reason for its foundation. So a compromise was reached: any club based in Sussex as a whole would be eligible to join (which let Worthing in), but ESCA activities – cycling and social – would be confined to the county to the east of the A23.

They thought it was all over. And it (surely) is, now. Mind you, in 1977 ESCA members (at a third special general meeting!) were divided over whether Croydon Road Club should be admitted. Some said the ESCA 50 and 100 would benefit from increased entries; others maintained that Croydon was too far away – and they won the argument.

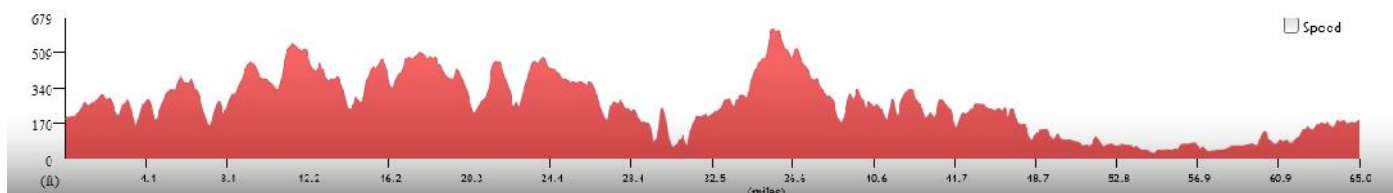

With winning times at each distance, Brighton Phoenix Tri's **Elisabeth Brama** makes her debut as the ESCA Ladies Best All Rounder with an average speed of 23.755, as does **Callum Middleton** in the Junior category with 24.670.
