Points are awarded to any club affiliated to ESCA based on the performance of its individual first claim members in each qualifying event. The individual points earned by each first claim rider are totalled and awarded to their respective club:

Veteran	Contested over 25, 50 and 100 miles in any ESCA event this season. Based on the best plus or minus at each distance added together proportionately – see note below.
Lady Senior	Contested over 10, 25 and 50 miles in any ESCA event this season. Based on an average mph from the best performance at each distance.
Lady Veteran	Contested over 10, 25 and 50 miles in any ESCA event this season. Based on the best plus or minus at each distance added together proportionately – see note below.
Junior	Contested over 10 and 25 miles in any ESCA event this season. Based on an average mph from the best performance at each distance.

The calculation for the ESCA Veteran BAR replicates that of the VTTA and following the introduction of new standards in 2012, their calculation changed from the original mph on actual compared with the mph on standard, and is now based on cumulative plus, added together proportionally.
