## 2014 Season Roundup



### Individual Points Competition

With a full house, Eastbourne Rovers' Matt Woods retains the points trophy for a second year with 234 points. His nemesis, Tom Glandfield of Lewes Wanderers, finished the season in second place with 211 points after missing the September 25. Another Rover, Iain Brogden, absent for the Counties 100, took third place on 199 points. There seems to be a pattern emerging here as another Wanderer, Matt Coombs, is fourth with 150 points followed by another Rover, George Welfare in fifth place with 136 points.

### 2014 ESCA Points Competition Rules

#### Individual Points

Points are awarded to any individual first claim rider from an ESCA affiliated club in each qualifying event:

Open Time Trials	30 points for first place down to 1 point for 30th place
2up Team Time Trial	30 points for each rider of first team down to 2 points for each rider of 15th team Composite teams and solo riders are not eligible for points

#### Club Points

Points are awarded to any club affiliated to ESCA based on the performance of its individual first claim members in each qualifying event. The individual points earned by each first claim rider are totalled and awarded to their respective club:

Open Time Trials	30 points for first place down to 1 point for 30th place
2up Team Time Trial	60 points for first team of two down to 4 points for 15th place Composite teams and solo riders are not eligible for points

Awards are presented at the annual luncheon to both the individual and club with the most points.



### 2014 ESCA Event Summary – Event 1 – ESCA Hardriders – Sunday 16 March 2014

After a long and miserable winter the weather couldn't have been nicer for the opening event of the ESCA calendar. Race favourite Peter Tadros led the way for an emphatic victory of 36:06 in the main event and 2:53.3 in the hill prime, to stamp his authority on the event yet again. Second place was shared by Steve Kane of Brighton Mitre and Pete Morris, now riding for ASL360, with 36:18 each. Recent Wanderer signing Tamar Vanderhaas took the ladies prize in 45:48, and in his first ever open event Rover Elliot Brown got off to a great start by taking the junior prize for 49:05. Eastbourne Rovers took the team win courtesy of Iain Brogden, John Cordner and Matt Woods with a combined time of 1:57:40.

The wet miserable conditions returned for the day, but at least it was mild! Unfortunately the Lewes pair, Nick Dwyer and Rob Pelham, fell victim to the poor road conditions when a pothole put a premature end to their ride and sent them both to hospital. Nick suffered a double break in his collar bone and Rob needed stitches to a rather nasty wound in his arm – we wish them both a full and speedy recovery.

Although it's not unusual for mates from different clubs to join forces as a composite team, the pairing of youth and experience turned quite a few heads in eager anticipation as the phenomenal Steve Kane from Brighton Excelsior teamed up with the legendary Steve Dennis of East Grinstead, and they didn't disappoint. They left the field behind with a blistering ride of 51:39. It's a shame they cannot reap the reward and recognition with the prizes and awards, but there are strict rules regarding composite teams. Second on the day, and ultimately the ESCA 2up trophy winners, were Robert Rollings and Tom Glandfield from Lewes Wanderers with 53:07. Rovers were also rewarded with the team prize thanks to the efforts of Matt Woods, Iain Brogden and Marc Townsend who pulled together for a combined effort of 1:06:29.
