2019 ESCA Points Competition & Rules

Individual Points: Points are awarded to any individual first claim rider from an ESCA affiliated club in each qualifying event. Riders who are not from an ESCA affiliated club or form a composite team in the 2up Team Time Trial, will be disregarded in the points allocation.

Open Time Trials

30 points for first place down to 1 point for 30th place

2up Team Time Trial

30 points for each rider of first team down to 2 points for each rider of 15th team
Composite teams and solo riders are not eligible for points

New for 2019 Ladies Individual Points: Points are awarded to any individual first claim female rider from an ESCA affiliated club in each qualifying event. Male riders, riders who are not from an ESCA affiliated club and mixed gender or composite teams in the 2up Team Time Trial, will be disregarded in the points allocation.

Open Time Trials

10 points for first place down to 1 point for 10th place

2up Team Time Trial

10 points for each rider of first female only team down to 2 points for each rider of 5th female only team
Composite teams, mixed gender teams, and solo riders are not eligible for points

Club Points: Points are awarded to any club affiliated to ESCA based on the performance of its individual first claim members in each qualifying event. The individual points earned by each first claim rider are totalled and awarded to their respective club. Riders who are not from an ESCA affiliated club or form a composite team in the 2up Team Time Trial, will be disregarded in the points allocation.

Open Time Trials

30 points for first place down to 1 point for 30th place

2up Team Time Trial

60 points for first team of two down to 4 points for 15th place
Composite teams and solo riders are not eligible for points

Awards are presented at the annual lunch to both the individual, female and club with the most points
